

Resilient ecosystems are key for a future-proof European agricultural sector and for growing healthy food and fiber for all

Why we, as progressive European farmers, support an ambitious EU Nature Restoration Law:

The EU co-legislators are right now negotiating the EU Nature Restoration Law. Media report that some groups would like to block the proposal for the EU Nature Restoration Law, presented by the Commission in June 2022. We oppose further delay to this new legislation. Regenerating nature cannot wait, also for reasons of food security.

In fact, it is the climate and biodiversity crises that are drastically affecting food production. These risks are already visible today, with climate-induced floods and droughts increasing and impacting food yield, also in Europe.

From 2021 to 2022, all of EU agricultural production dropped significantly. The core reasons for this are animal diseases and droughts¹. Drought is also the reason why the compound annual growth rate of per hectare production of cash crops in major EU agricultural sectors has come to a standstill in the last 20 years². The impacts of droughts on EU agricultural production continue to intensify³.

Food production fundamentally depends upon healthy ecosystems and the services biodiversity provides, such as healthy soils, nutrient cycling, reliable water retention, abundant fish stocks and pollination. To avoid worse food security threats, we must properly tackle the drivers of biodiversity loss and the climate crisis, through coordinated practical, legal and political action, not delay them.










The EU Nature Restoration Law is a generation's opportunity to take concrete and effective action to reverse the biodiversity and climate crises, by restoring EU land and sea areas at large scale. We, the undersigned farmers and farming associations, working incessantly ourselves to aid nature through producing healthy food regeneratively in Europe's agroecosystems, are calling for the urgent adoption of an ambitious and legally binding EU Nature Restoration Law. This is key for the building of ecological antifragility, economic resilience and a future-proof EU food security by driving


